

The word 'assumption' comes from the Latin word assomption which means "taking up".


In many countries this feast day is a holy day of obligation which means everyone should go to mass on this day. However, in Ireland that is no longer the case. It is traditional in some countries such as Germany, to bless herbs on the feast of the Assumption using the Blessing of Fruits and Herbs. This prayer acknowledges how God created plants for our use as food and medicine but recognises them also as his gift of beauty.

To celebrate this special day, you can say the Glorious Mysteries of the rosary together as a family, or just the decade focused on the Assumption.
